- How do the time scales of climate change and climate action interact or crossover? Use Dr. McDonald's sea level rise example as well as one other example in your area of expertise as an example.
- In 500 words, explain how climate change influences social injustice? Provide 3 clear examples. See America Adapts episodes 111, 108, 106, and others for more examples.
- Take a position: when doing climate change adaptation work in communities or with populations where climate change discussions may still be taboo, is it necessary to insist on discussing climate change (i.e. by name)? Why or why not? Prepare to defend your position in a classroom discussion.
- Is climate adaptation ever finished? How do you know?



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
